



CONSIGNMENT CONTRACT

First and foremost, thank you for choosing to consign with us.
We know you have many other options and we truly appreciate it!

Here are a few guidelines to help you better understand our process:

- We encourage you to browse through our store to acquaint yourself with the price ranges we set.
- Clothing must be in excellent condition and of current styles that are in demand.
- When bringing items in, please make sure they are clean and free of defects; it is not necessary to bring them in on hangers.
- Please do not take offense if we find it necessary to decline any of your items. We rely on past and present experience of what sells as well as current inventory to make our selections.
- To help with the sale of your items, we price them as we see fit and do not guarantee prices on any pieces. Revisions of the selling price may be made at the stores discretion.

How it works:

- When an item is sold, the consigner receives 50% of the selling price.
- Payouts are done the 16th of each month.
- You must contact us before the end of the pay period if they wish to receive their check via mail.
- Checks less than \$30 can be cashed out at any time.
- Items will remain on the floor for 90 days. Those left unsold at the end of the consignment period will become property of Cherry Picked Consignments and will be donated.
- If you wish to pick up your unsold items, it is your responsibility to do so, we will not contact you.
- We will do our best to protect your items but we are not responsible for loss or damage to any item for any reason, including but not limited to, theft, breakage, or fire.
- When you bring items in to consign, please wait for your receipt and your returns. If not, all returns will be donated after the second business day.
